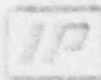

This is in reply to the referenced letter which requested confirmation by Illinois Power Company regarding the implementation dates for emergency support facilities as provided in Enclosure 1 to the referenced letter.

The Clinton Power Station operating license application is currently in the OL review process, and the OL for Unit 1 is scheduled for issuance after October 1, 1982. Therefore, all required licensing submittals for emergency support facilities will be furnished in a time frame supporting the OL review process. This position is consistent with the implementation requirements for action plan item III.A.1.2.
