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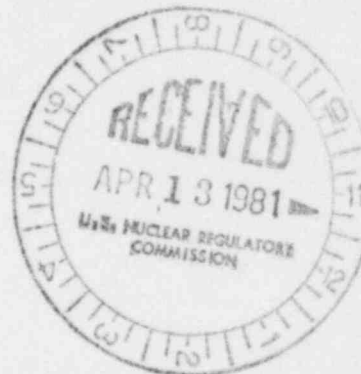

J. Blotcky at the conclusion of the inspection on February 11, 1981.

The areas examined during the inspection and our findings are discussed in the enclosed inspection report. 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
