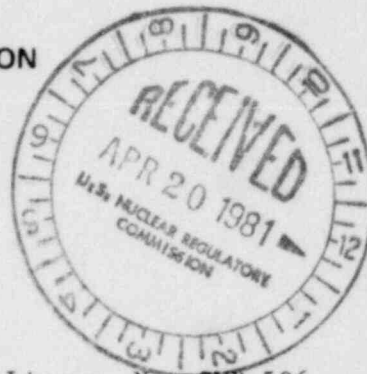

This refers to the management meeting on February 27, 1981, at our Region III office, at which you, Mr. A. J. Cipolla, and other Allied Chemical representatives discussed activities authorized by NRC License No. SUB-526 with Mr. C. E. Norelius and others of my staff.

The meeting combined a Systematic Appraisal of Licensee Performance (SALP) evaluation with an enforcement conference related to the apparent over-exposure to airborne radioactivity of an employee at the Metropolis Works.

The meeting served to give us an understanding of the actions you have taken and plan to reduce radiation exposures. We hope it provided you with a better understanding of our appraisal program and enforcement policies.

No items of noncompliance with NRC requirements were identified as a result of this meeting.
