As you know, the fact that the Three Mile Island I nuclear reactor has remained out of service since early 1979 has imposed great costs on the ratepayers of New Jersey and Pennsylvania and has severely strained the financial resources of the General Public Utilities Corporation and its subsidiaries.

I certainly hope that the Commission will take all necessary actions to bring this reactor back into operation as soon as possible. The continuing delays in approving the re-start of this plant, and its associated costs, are unconscionable.

I would appreciate learning of the Commission's actions and plans in this regard.
