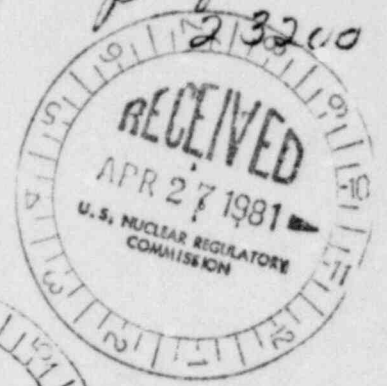
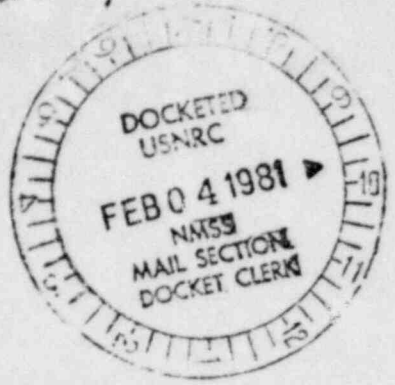

Enclosed are 15 copies of an application for a special nuclear material license for the Bellefonte Nuclear Plant unit 2. This application is filed pursuant to the Commission's regulations in 10 CFR Part 70 requesting authorization for receipt, possession, and storage of unit 2 assembled fuel assemblies, the balance of unit 1 fuel (270 assemblies total), and up to 100 loose fuel rods at the Bellefonte Nuclear Plant.

In accordance with 10 CFR 170.11(a)3 an amendment fee is not required.

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
