
Dear Sir:

Pursuant to 5 USC, §552, I am submitting a request to you for certain information. I am attempting to find any data you may have concerning the January 3, 1961 explosion of the Stationary Low Power Reactor, No. 1 (SL1) at the Idaho Falls, Idaho, National Reactor Testing Station. Additionally, do you have any data relative to the subsequent demolition and disposal of the SL1 reactor?

Specifically, my inquiry is directed to any facts and investigations made of the incident, reports concerning the accident and clean-up operations, the safety precautions utilized during the clean-up operations, contracts between the U.S. Government, including agencies other than yours, and the General Electric Corporation relative to the project and the clean-up operation.

I would request an estimate of the costs involved in this request be sent to me prior to a records search. Additionally, should more specific data be needed, please inform me so that an effort to provide it can be made.
