Dear Dr. Krejsa:

Your letter of September 16, 1976, to Mr. Lee V. Gossick has been referred to me for reply.

We are pleased to hear that the San Luis Obispo Board of Supervisors voted to draft a radiological emergency response plan. As we indicated in our letter to Congressman Lagomarsino on August 19, we conducted a one-week training course in Sacramento in November, 1975 on "Radiological Emergency Response Planning in Support of Fixed Nuclear Facilities" which was attended by Mr. George Silva and Mr. Timothy Mazzacano of San Luis Obispo County, and by Mr. Kenneth Huddelston of the California Parks and Recreation Department in San Luis Obispo County. We strongly suggest that you include these individuals on your team which is preparing the plan for San Luis Obispo County. They should be able to answer many of your questions relative to this subject.

Concerning the agreement between Sierra Vista Hospital and Pacific Gas and Electric to provide facilities and services in time of need, we checked with our licensing division and as of October 1, 1976, the letter of agreement between that hospital and Pacific Gas and Electric Company is still valid.

If we can be of any assistance to you, please call Mr. Harold Collins, Acting Assistant Director for Emergency Preparedness at 301-492-7210. In addition, we would appreciate receiving a copy of the San Luis Obispo County plan when it is completed.
