This refers to the routine safety inspection conducted by G. A. Belisle and others of this office on February 23-26, 1981, of activities authorized by NRC Operating License No. DPR-77 for the Sequoyah facility and to the discussion of our findings held with J. M. McGriff and W. E. Andrews at the conclusion of the inspection.

This inspection was a comprehensive examination of your management and quality assurance controls related to licensed activities. Inspection was conducted in selected key areas of responsibility at both the plant site and your corporate offices. Areas examined during the inspection and our findings are discussed in the enclosed inspection report. Within these areas, the inspection consisted of selective examinations of procedures and representative records, interviews with personnel, and observations by the inspectors.

Within the scope of this inspection, no violations or deviations were disclosed.

Four new unresolved items resulted from this inspection and are discussed in the enclosed report. These items will be examined during subsequent inspections.

In accordance with Section 2.790 of the NRC's "Rules of Practice", Part 2, Title 10, Code of Federal Regulations, a copy of this letter and the enclosed inspection report will be placed in the NRC's Public Document Room.
