This refers to your request for a radiation survey of the property between Grey and Esplanade Streets on Passaic Avenue referred to as the former location of the "Intercity Bus Terminal." As Ms. M. Campbell of this office discussed with yourself and Messrs. Greber and Scanel on March 13, 1981, the radiation survey of this property indicated that no area of the property had a radiation level measuring more than 10 microroentgens per hour. This is consistent with natural background in northern New Jersey.

In addition, the data supplied by Myron's consultants, as based upon Robert J. Carlin, P.E. drawing, Rev. No. 1, dated Jan. 26, 1981 and the subsequent testing of the borings taken at indicated locations is further acceptable as indications of the fact that no undue hazard will be associated with the proposed building on this site.
