This refers to your request for a radiation survey of the property between Grey and Esplanade Streets on Passaic Avenue referred to as the former location of the "Intercity Bus Terminal." As Ms. M. Greber and Scanel on March 13, 1981, the radiation survey of this property indicated that no area of the property had a radiation level measuring more than 10 microrentgens per hour. This is consistent with natural background in northern New Jersey.

Pursuant to your request regarding subject's proposed building site, we submit the enclosed Nuclear Regulatory Commission's finding and accept their conclusion which is summarized in the final sentence "It is unlikely that there would be a hazard associated with construction or occupancy of such a building on the property surveyed."

In addition, the data supplied by Myron's consultants, as based upon Robert J. Carlin, P.E. drawing, Rev. No. 1, dated Jan. 26, 1981 and the subsequent testing of the borings taken at indicated locations is further acceptable as indications of the fact that no undue hazard will be associated with the proposed building on this site.
