POSSIBLE STRIKE BY CONTRACT GUARD FORCE

An unsubstantiated report was received by the licensee indicating that at 4:00 A.M., on April 30, 1981, the contract guard/force supplied by Burns International Security Services, Inc. (Burns) will go on strike, leaving the site en masse. The strike has been called by the Power Plant Police & Security Officers, Local 1 (contract guard force affiliation). The licensee is implementing the Strike Contingency Plan, and will have available a sufficient number of qualified supervisory personnel, supplied by Burns, to immediately meet their Security Plan requirements at the time of the walk-out. The SRI is following up license onsite strike preparations.

Media interest is expected due to public interest in activities at this site. A press release is not planned by the licensee or the NRC at this time.

The Commonwealth of Pennsylvania has been informed. The Pennsylvania State Police have been notified and the IAT has been informed.

Region I (Philadelphia) received notification of this potential occurrence from the licensee at 11:25 a.m. on April 29, 1981.
