Dear Mr. Springer:

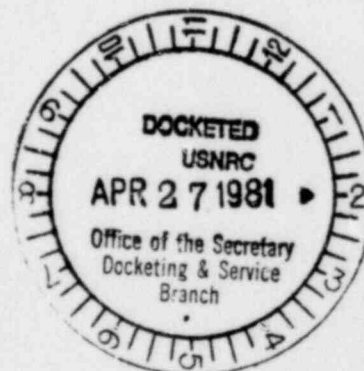
