I have recently received a copy of the proposed rule entitled, "Exemption of Technetium-99 and Low-Enriched Uranium As Residual Contamination in Smelted Alloys" (the comment period on which expired on December 11, 1980). Almost a month ago now, the papers noted public hearings on an issue which was apparently related to this proposed rule change—if not the proposed rule change itself.
