Haddam Neck Plant
Millstone Nuclear Power Station, Unit Nos. 1 and 2
Fire Protection

In fulfillment of the requirements of 10CFR50.48 and Appendix R to 10CFR50, Connecticut Yankee Atomic Power Company (CYAPCO) and Northeast Nuclear Energy Company (NNECO) docketed Reference (1). Reference (1) included a number of exemption requests for each of the three operating units, and justification for these requests was provided. The provisions of 10CFR170 were not addressed at that time but have since been discussed with the Staff and are summarized as follows:

## III.0, Oil Collection System for Reactor Coolant Pumps

### Haddam Neck Plant

The exempt on request from the requirements of Section III.0 constitutes a Class III Amendment as the request involves a single safety issue and does not involve a significant hazards consideration. Therefore, the appropriate fee for this request is \$4,000.

### Millstone Unit No. 2

An exemption request was also docketed for Millstone Unit No. 2. For similar reasons, this request constitutes a Class III Amendment for which the appropriate fee is again \$4,000.

# III.G, Fire Protection of Safe Shutdown Capability III.L, Alternate and Dedicated Shutdown Capability

#### Haddam Neck Plant

Reference (1) requested an exemption from the requirements of 10CFR50.48(c)(5). This action constitutes a Class II Amendment as the exemption deals with schedular considerations only and is, therefore, administrative in nature. The appropriate amendment fee for this class is \$1,200.

### Millstone Unit No. 1

A similar request was docketed in Reference (1) for Millstone Unit No. 1. The appropriate amendment fee is \$1,200.

### Millstone Unit No. 2

A similar request was docketed in Reference (1) for Millstone Unit No. 2. The appropriate amendment fee is \$1,200.

In fulfillment of the provisions of 10CFR170, included herewith is payment in the amount of eleven thousand six hundred dollars (\$11,600) which constitutes full payment for two Class III Amendment requests and three Class II Amendment requests.

As noted in Reference (1), additional reviews planned by CYAPCO and NNECO on the subject of Appendix R may result in the docketing of subsequent exemption requests from substantive technical requirements.
