SUBJECT: SITE ALERT DECLARED DUE TO HIGH LEAKAGE INTO DRYWELL

At 12:35 a.m. (CDT) on May 22, an unidentified leak in the drywell occurred accountry controlled shutdown was initiated. The maximum leakrate was 21.5 gpm. The Technical Specification limit for total leakrate is 25 gpm. The reactor was operating at 100 percent power at the time. The reactor was manually scrammed from 30 percent power at 1:23 a.m. There was no radioactive release to the environment and no contamination of personnel.

The licensee declared a site alert at 12:35 a.m., due to the potential to exceed the leakrate of 25 gpm in their emergency plan. The site alert was terminated at 0224 a.m. Preparations are now being made to determine the source of leakage.

The resident inspector arrived onsite at 2:45 a.m. and is monitoring activities.

Wide media interest has occurred. The licensee has made a press release. The State of Alabama has been notified.

The NRC Emergency Response Center received notification of this occurrence at 2:00 a.m. EDT May 22, 1981. This information is current as of 10:30 a.m. EDT on May 22.
