Dear Mr. Sreniawski,

The NRC inspection of March 23, 1981, outlined three items of non-compliance in the Nuclear Medicine Department of Marshall County Parkview Hospital (License #13-18880-01). The items are: 1. A failure to conduct quarterly inventory on three calibration sources. 2. A failure of the Medical Isotopes Committee to meet quarterly. 3. A failure to inspect and receive radioactive packages in the proper manner.

Our Radiation Safety Officer was informed of the violations and he in turn worked out procedures with the Chief Nuclear Medicine Technologists to ensure future compliance with Federal regulations. A source inventory sheet was made up which includes the names and identification inventory numbers for all sealed sources such that none will be overlooked on future source inventories. This sheet includes a space for the location of each so ce t the time of inventory and the date of inventory. The sheet has been given to the Chief Nuclear Medicine Technologist with instructions that he should perform such inventories at least quarterly. In addition, a back-up inventory is being performed by the Radiation Safety Officer.

A calendar for all Medical Isotope Committee meetings for 1981 has been distributed to all members of the Isotope Committee meeting and the importance of these meetings is being affirmed to each of them.

Finally, packages are being received according to the procedures of Appendix F of Regulatory Guide 10.8 and the radioactive shipment receipt form in that Appendix is being used to record the data. This procedure has already been implemented.

I affirm that the above statements are true. To the best of my knowledge we are currently in compliance with all Federal regulations at this time. It is our intension to remain in compliance with all the appropriate Federal regulations.
