This refers to the routine safety inspection conducted by Messrs. C. Rowe and J. Nicolosi of this office on April 20, 1981 of activities authorized by NRC License No. 06-07150-01 and to the discussions of our findings held by Messrs. Rowe and Nicolosi with Lieutenant Marsh of your staff at the conclusion of the inspection.

The inspection was an examination of activities conducted under your license as they relate to radiation safety and to compliance with the Commission's rules and regulations and the conditions of your license. The inspection consisted of selective examinations of procedures and representative records, interviews with personnel, measurements made by the inspector, and observations by the inspector.

Our inspector also verified the steps you have taken to correct the item of noncompliance brought to your attention in the enclosure to our letter dated April 25, 1980. We have no further questions regarding your action at this time.

Within the scope of this inspection, no items of noncompliance were observed.
