Subject: Inspection 81-01

This refers to the routine safety inspection conducted by Mr. C. Rowe of this office on March 26, 1981, of activities authorized by NRC License No. 29-13848-01 and to the discussions of our findings held by Mr. Rowe with yourself at the conclusion of the inspection.

The inspection was an examination of activities conducted under your license as they relate to radiation safety and to compliance with the Commission's rules and regulations and the conditions of your license. The inspection consisted of selective examinations of procedures and representative records, interviews with personnel, measurements made by the inspector, and observations by the inspector.

In addition, our inspector took a water sample from your irradiation pool and smear samples of your restricted areas. These samples were analyzed in our Regional Office Laboratory in King of Prussia, Pennsylvania. The basic purpose of these independent measurements is to verify your capability to determine the concentration of radioactive material in your pool water and to analyze removable contamination. The results of our analyses are in agreement with your analyses.

Within the scope of this inspection, no items of noncompliance were observed.

In accordance with Section 2.790 of the NRC's "Rules of Practice," Part 2, Title 10, Code of Federal Regulations, a copy of this letter will be placed in the Public Document Room.
