
The upgraded emergency response facilities for Comanche Peak Steam Electric Station (except the integrated ERF computer facilities) will be operational prior to receiving an operating license.

The additional guidance of final NUREG-0696 is still under review at this time.

Per a telephone conversation on May 13, 1981 with Mr. Ed Williams of the Emergency Preparedness Development Branch, it was agreed that Texas Utilities Generating Company will submit schedules for the items listed below after issuance of a clarification to Generic Letter 81-10.

- 1) Facility Conceptual Design Description
- 2) Staffing Levels for Emergency Situations
- 3) Integrated ERF Computer Facilities
