Subject: Inspection 81-01

This refers to the routine safety inspection conducted by Mr. P. Jerman of this office on February 25, 1981, of activities authorized by NRC License Nos. 06-00253-04 and SNM-1454 and to the discussions of our findings held by Mr. Jerman with Messrs. Rice, Dresick and Mas of your staff at the conclusion of the inspection.

The inspection was an examination of activities conducted under your license as they relate to radiation safety and to compliance with the Commission's rules and regulations and the conditions of your license. The inspection consisted of selective examinations of procedures and representative records, interviews with personnel, measurements made by the inspector, and observations by the inspector.

Our inspector also verified the steps you have taken to correct the items of noncompliance and deviation brought to your attention in a letter and enclosure dated February 21, 1980. We have no further questions regarding your action at this time.

Based on the results of this inspection, it appears that certain of your activities were not conducted in full compliance with NRC requirements, as set forth in the Notice of Violation, enclosed herewith as Appendix A. These items of noncompliance have been categorized into the levels described in the Federal Register Notice (45 FR 66754) dated October 7, 1980. You are required to respond to this letter and in preparing your response, you should follow the instructions in Appendix A.


