1. The Naval Coastal Systems Center was issued Nuclear Regulatory Commission Byproduct Material License No. 09-17121-02 on 25 September 1979. In accordance with 10 CFR 71.12(b)(1)(iii), it is requested that this Command be registered as a user of the Nuclear Regulatory Commission Certificate of Compliance No. 4888, issued to Teledyne Energy Systems, Identification No. USA/4888/B.
2. The Radioisotope Thermoelectric Generators (RTGs) are to be removed from operation on Stage I, transported to NCSC for temporary storage, with subsequent transfer to another properly licensed agency.
3. Enclosure (1), a description of the quality assurance program required by 10 CFR 71.51, is forwarded for your approval.
4. Your prompt action on these matters will be greatly appreciated as present operations require the RTGs to be removed from Stage I at the earliest possible date.
