The following items contitute a reply to your letter dated March 31, 1981 concerning an inspection (No. 81-01) of our facility conducted by Mr. Nicolosi on February 25 and 26, 1981:

- The technology staff has been informed that they should regularly Al. survey their hands for contamination. This will be emphasized periodically. Spot checks for hand contamination will also be made by health physics.
- Syringe shields are in use during dose preparation. A2.
- The personnel in the lab in question have been instructed on the В. proper use of designated waste containers. Nuclear Medicine personnel will survey on a weekly basis the waste baskets in the lab. Health physics makes period inspections in the lab and surveys the waste containers during the inspections.
