Webster of this office on March 6 - April 5, 1981, of activities authorized by NRC NPF-4 and NPF-7 for the North Anna facility and to the discussion of our findings held with Mr. W. R. Cartwright, Station Manager, at the conclusion of the inspection.

Areas examined during the inspection and our findings are discussed in the enclosed inspection report. Within these areas, the inspection consisted of selective examinations of procedures and representative records, interviews with personnel, and observations by the inspector.

Within the scope of this inspection, no violations or caviations were disclosed.

We have examined actions you have taken with regard to previously identified enforcement matters. These are discussed in the enclosed inspection report.

If we do not hear from you within the specified period, the report will be placed in the Public Document Room.
