This refers to the routine inspection conducted by Mr. J. McCann of this office on January 5-9, 1981 at Pilgrim Nuclear Power Station, Unit 1 of activities authorized by NRC License No. DPR-35 and to the discussions of our findings held by Mr. McCann with Mr. C. J. Mathis and other members of your staff at the conclusion of the inspection.

Areas examined during this inspection are described in the Office of Inspection and Enforcement Inspection Report which is enclosed with this letter. Within these areas, the inspection consisted of selective examinations of procedures and representative records, interviews with personnel, and observations by the inspector.

Our inspector also verified the steps you have taken to correct the items of noncompliance brought to your attention in the enclosures to our letters dated September 15, 1977; August 10, 1979; and January 21, 1980. We have no further questions regarding your action at this time.

Based on the results of this inspection, it appears that certain of your activities were not conducted in full compliance with NRC requirements, as set forth in the Notice of Violation, enclosed herewith as Appendix A. These items of noncompliance have been categorized into the levels described in the Federal Register Notice (45 FR 66754) dated October 7, 1980.

In accordance with Section 2.790 of the NRC's "Rules of Practice," Part 2, Title 10, Code of Federal Regulations, a copy of this letter and the enclosures will be placed in the NRC's Public Document Roon. If this report contains any information that you (or your contractor) believe to be proprietary, it is necessary that you make a written application within 25 days to this office to withhold such information from public disclosure. Any such application must be accompanied by an affidavit executed by the owner of the information, which identificate document or part sought to be withheld, and which contains a statement easons which addresses with specificity the items which will be considered by the Commission as listed in subparagraph (b) (4) of Section 2.790. The mation sought to be withheld shall be incorporated as far as possible into a suparate part of the affidavit. If we do not hear from you in this regard within the specified period, the report will be placed in the Public Document Room.
