
Dear Mr. McClintock:

Our hospital is currently undergoing an expansion and renovation project by Hospital Building and Equipment Company of St. Louis, Missouri. There is some concern amongst our staff as to the conformance of the design of the new isotope storage area with applicable NRC Regulations.

The attached sketch shows the design of the storage area within a room containing our Gamma Camera (Scans). It is the belief of some of our staff that the storage area should have a separate door with a lock in addition to the door to the Scan room which has a lock. During the design, the Architect contended that the presence of a lock on the door to the Scan room fulfilled the requirements of applicable regulations.

Please review the attached sketch and advise us whether the room as designed meets your requirements for accessibility. If it does not, please state the reasons so that we can forward them to our Architect and have appropriate changes made. Your expeditious consideration of this matter would be appreciated as we are already under construction. 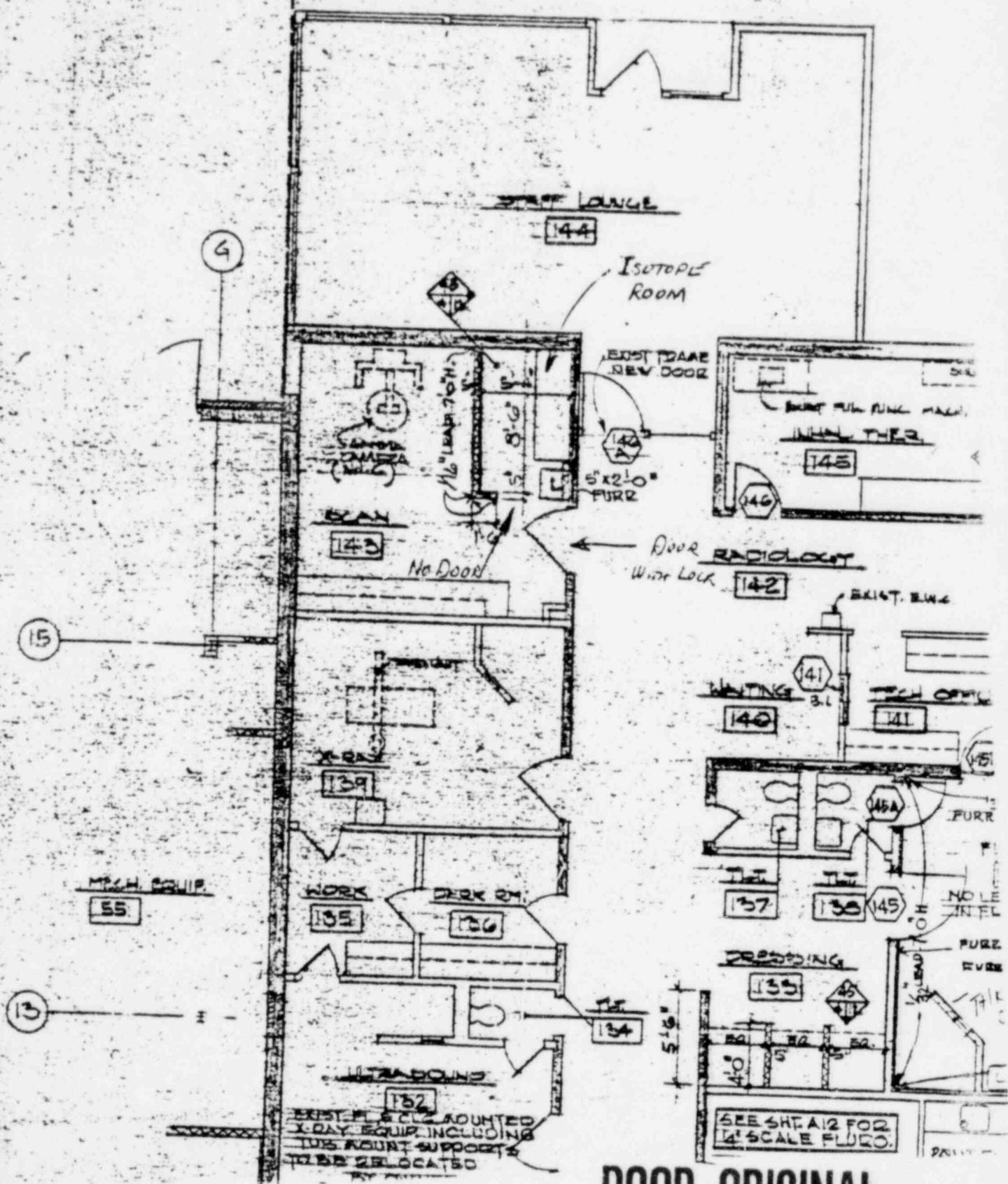
