Summer Nuclear Station, Unit No. 1, located in Fairfield County, South Carolina, is available for inspection by the public in the Commission's Public Document Room at 1717 H Street, N. W., Washington, D. C., and in the Richland County Public Library, 1400 Sumter Street, Columbia, South Carolina 29201. The Final Environmental Statement is also being made available at the State Clearinghouse, Office of the State Auditor, P. O. Box 11333, Columbia, South Carolina 29211, and at the Central Midlands Regional Planning Council, 800 Dutch Square Boulevard, Columbia, South Carolina 29210.

The notice of availability of the Draft Environmental Statement for the Virgil C. Summer Nuclear Station, Unit 1 and requests for comments from interested persons was published in the FEDERAL REGISTER on July 9, 1979 (44 F.R. 40130). A notice of availability of a Supplement to the Draft Environmental Statement and request for comments was published in the FEDERAL REGISTER on November 14, 1980 (45 FR 75399). The comments received from Federal, State, and local agencies, and interested members of the public have been included as appendices in the Final Environmental Statement.
