
Under the Freedom of Information Act (5 USC 332), we request a copy of all letters between the Nuclear Regulatory Commission and Transnuclear Inc. (White Plains, NY) regarding the shipment of spent fuel from the Chalk River experimental reactor, Ontario to Savannah River, South Carolina, including the specific routing information. It is our understanding that Transnuclear Inc. is the new shipper, having taken over the function of National Lead Industries that had the previous contract. The 1980 shipments were routed through Ogdensburg, New York, but it is our understanding that the 1981 shipments will be routed through the State of Michigan.

It is also our understanding that this routing information was to have been provided by the NRC to the public on a timely basis. Since this information has not been made available, we are applying under the FOIA at this time.

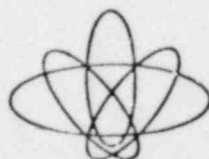
We agree to pay all charges under \$25. If the charges are greater, we wish a listing of all information in the possession of the NRC in this matter. Thank you for a prompt response.
