The Commission discussed the subject paper without reaching a final decision.

The Commission requested that the proposed final rule be revised to:

- 1. clarify the language in the rule to identify that the rule would not apply to the CRBR; (EDO)
- modify the reason for rejecting USDI's comments (pgs. 17-18 of Attachment 3 to the subject paper) to remove the legal rationale and to indicate instead that as a matter of policy it is not necessary to await the completion of a siting rulemaking for these specific applicants:
- 3. update the expected availability date for the IEEE/ANS methodology for the PRA study (pg. 33 of Attachment 3 to the subject paper). (EDO)

The Commission requested that the appropriate conforming changes to Appendix B of Part 2 be prepared for Commission consideration. (OGC)

Pending further Commission guidance, the staff was authorized, if it deems appropriate, to proceed with a review of applications on the basis of the revised NUREG-0718 and entire into hearings with that position.
