Supplement E

- 1. The radiation protection program is described in AMCR 385-25 with CERCOM Supplement 1 (See Incl 1) and the combined directive on Radiation Protection (See Incl 2).
- 2. Leak tests will be performed by the RPO or a technical member of his staff.
- 3. Initial radiation surveys are made by the RPO or a technical member of his staff or by the US Army Environmental Hygiene Agency.
- 4. Lexington-Blue Grass Army Depot Film Badge Service is used for personnel monitoring on a monthly basis for radiation workers and on an as needed basis for visitors.
- 5. Bioassay services are available through the Army Surgeon General as required.
