Subject: Inspection 81-01

This refers to the routine safety inspection conducted by Mr. J. Davis of this office on May 15, 1981 of activities authorized by NRC License No. 37-12931-02 and to the discussions of our findings held by Mr. Davis with Mr. J. Dulissey and Mr. S. Davidson of your staff at the conclusion of the inspection.

The inspection was an examination of activities conducted under your license as they relate to radiation safety and to compliance with the Commission's rules and regulations and the conditions of your license. The inspection consisted of selective examinations of procedures and representative records, interviews with personnel, and observations by the inspector.

Our inspector also verified the steps you have taken to correct the items of noncompliance brought to your attention in the enclosure to our letter dated May 9, 1980. We have no further questions regarding your action at this time.

Within the scope of this inspection, no items of noncompliance were observed.
