SUBJECT: SUMMARY OF JUNE 5, 1981 'EETING REGARDING EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS

1. General

Representatives of the staff met with representatives of the applicant and its consultant Dames & Moore, to discuss Appendix 2 to NUREG-0654, Revision 1. The meeting was held at the staff's offices in Bethesda, Md. A list of those persons who attended the meeting is included in the enclosure.

2. Purpose

The purpose of the meeting was to review the applicant's work to date in implementing its commitment to comply with Appendix 2 to NUREG-0654, Revision 1.


3. Discussion

The staff reviewed the requirements of Appendix 2 to NUREG-0654, Revision 1. Two alternatives are afforded by Appendix 2 to applicants seeking an operating license. The first is to establish compliance with the requirements in Appendix 2 that must be implemented by July 1, 1982. The other is to institute certain compensating action prior to issuance of the operating license and establish complete compliance with Appendix 2 requirements by July 1, 1982. We noted that we were considering moving the July 1, 1982 implementation date to October 1, 1982.

After considerable discussion, the applicant stated that it would elect the option of addressing the compensating actions specified in Appendix 2 and establish complete compliance some time later. The applicant discussed in general their proposed approach to satisfy the compensating actions of Appendix 2 and it appeared to be acceptable. The applicant plans to file a response within the next two weeks.
