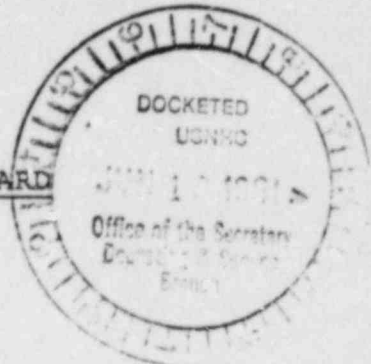


PROCEDURES FOR INSPECTION AND COPYING


CFUR may inspect and copy the documents identified above according to the following procedures:
