NOTICE OF VIOLATION

The University of Michigan

License No. 21-00215-04

As a result of the investigation conducted on September 11-12, 18-19, 1980 and January 5, 1981, and in accordance with the Interim Enforcement Policy, 45 FR 66754 (October 7, 1980), the following violations were identified:

1. Condition 20 of your license requires that licensed material be possessed and used in accordance with statements, representations, and procedures contained in the application received July 29, 1977.

Appendix B, the Radionuclide User's Manual of that application states in Section C.1.3, "eating and drinking, in the laboratory is forbidden."

Contrary to these requirements, on September 12, 1980, the NRC inspector observed an individual eating in the laboratory. Further, the inspector learned from statements of three of the individuals who routinely worked in the laboratory that eating and drinking in the laboratory was done on several other occasions in 1980.

This is a Severity Level V violation (Supplement VII).


2. 10 CFR 19.12 requires that you instruct all individuals working in your restricted area in the precautions and procedures to minimize exposure to radiation and radioactive materials, and in the applicable provisions of the Commission's regulations and licenses.

Contrary to this requirement, from May 19, 1980 to August 15, 1980, you failed to instruct three of your employees that oral pipetting of radioactive solutions is forbidden.

This is a Severity Level V violation (Supplement VII).

Pursuant to the provisions of 10 CFR 2.201, you are required to submit to this office within twenty-five days of the date of this Notice a written statement or explanation in reply, including for each item of noncompliance: (1) corrective action taken and the results achieved; (2) corrective action to be taken to avoid further noncompliance; and (3) the date when full compliance will be achieved. Under the authority of Section 182 of the Atomic Energy Act of 1954, as amended, this response shall be submitted under oath or affirmation.
