

Dear Captain Titrud:



In 1979 the Staff of the Nuclear Regulatory Commission requested the Air Force to update an analysis done in 1971 of the possibility of such a crash. This analysis was forwarded to us in January 1980. If it becomes necessary, we would appreciate the help of Major Betourne and Mr. C. J. Thomas, AF/SASB, as the people who prepared this analysis, at the hearing which are to take place in Charlevoix, Michigan in the fall and/or winter of this year. This assistance would involve the preparation of affidavits for motions for summary disposition and possibly testimony at the hearing itself.

The Staff would all o appreciate the Air Force's assistance, if it becomes necessary, in providing general information concerning B-52 bomber operations. Since it is not known as yet whether such information will be required, I am unable to say at this time exactly what form this assistance would take.
