This refers to the investigation conducted by Messrs. G. A. Phillip and R. E. Burgin of this office on April 1-2, 1981, of activities at a field job site in Marquette, Michigan, authorized by NRC Byproduct Materials License No. 48-16296-01 and to the discussion of our findings with you at the conclusion of the investigation.

The investigation was conducted following receipt of a complaint that radiography may not have been conducted in a safe manner. The investigation consisted of an examination of pertinent procedures and records, observations and interviews of individuals.

No items of noncompliance with NRC requirements were identified during this investigation.

In accordance with 10 CFR 2.790 of the Commission's regulations, a copy of this letter and the enclosed investigation report will be placed in the NRC's Public Document Room. If this report contains any information that you or your contractors believe to be exempt from disclosure under 10 CFR 9.5(a)(4), it is necessary that you (a) notify this office by tele hone within seven (7) days from the date of this letter of your intention to file a request for withholding; and (b) submit within twenty-five (25) days from the date of this letter a written application to this office to withhold such information. Section 2.790(b)(1) requires that any such application must be accompanied by an affidavit executed by the owner of the information which identifies the document or part sought to be withheld, and which contains a full statement of the reasons on the basis which it is claimed that the information should be withheld from public disclosure. This section further requires the statement to address with specificity the considerations listed in 10 CFR 2.790(b)(4). The information sought to be withheld shall be incorporated as far as possible into a separate part of the affidavit. If we do not hear from you in this regard within the specified periods noted above, a copy of this letter and the enclosed investigation report will be placed in the Public Document Room.
