Gentlemen:

The purpose of this letter is to revise a portion of the B&V response to NRC Inspection Report No. 99900526/80-01. B&V's initial response to the Inspection Report was included in our letter dated September 12, 1980.

All of the corrective actions defined in our previous letter have been completed with the exception of the final check of the drawing index and the PQCE survey that were discussed under item A(c). It was originally stated that these actions would be completed by July 15, 1981. However, during the last several months, Project Management for Black Fox Station has been investigating several alternative methods of utilizing the computer based drawing list. A decision has now been reached and an effort has been initiated which will result in significant revisions to the computer data base during the next six months. Because of the aforementioned activities the final check of the index will not be completed until January 15, 1982.

The requested delay in completing the subject corrective action will not adversely affect any of the ongoing work on the Black Fox Station project since nearly all design and procurement work has been terminated pending a restart of licensing activities.


