The emergency plan exercise discussed in references (b) and (c) has been rescheduled for Saturday, September 26, 1981.

We have rescheduled this drill in consideration of the adverse financial impact which would fall upon volunteer emergency workers in the twenty local communities if the exercise were to be held on a normal working day.
