Dear Mr. Madsan:

On May 22, 1981. Mr. E.W. Creel made a telephone report to Mr. W. Hubacek regarding nonconformance of specification requirements on approximately 20,000 feet of Rockbestos cable delivered to the Wolf Creek Renerating Station Unit 1 site.

An investigation is currently being conducted to determine the location of all the remaining Rockbestos cable on site. Preliminary data indicates that approximately 130,000 feet of cable is involved. This cable has been placed on hold until the nonconforming lab test results have been dispositioned.

The results of this investigation and the action to be taken will be reported to your office on or before August 31, 1981.
