As a result of the inspection conducted on May 6, 1981, and in accordance with the Interim Enforcement Policy, 45 FR 66754 (October 7, 1980), the following violation was identified:

Condition 14 of your license requires that licensed material be possessed and used in accordance with the statements, representations and procedures contained in your application dated February 16, 1977.


Item 11 of this application requires that your survey meter be calibrated on an annual basis.

Contrary to this requirement, as of the day of inspection, May 6, 1981, your survey meter was last calibrated in January 1980, a period more than one year.

This is a Severity Level V Violation (Supplement VII).

Pursuant to the provisions of 10 CFR 2.201, Stephen N. Fisher, M.D., is hereby required to submit to this office within twenty-five days of the date of this Notice, a written statement or explanation in reply, including: (1) the corrective steps which have been taken and the results achieved; (2) corrective steps which will be taken to avoid further violations; and (3) the date when full compliance will be achieved. Under the authority of Section 182 of the Atomic Energy Act of 1954, as amended, this response shall be submitted under oath or affirmation.
