## NOTICE OF VIOLATION

As a result of the inspection conducted on April 21, 1981, and in accordance with the Interim Enforcement Policy, 45 FR 66754 (October 7, 1980), the following violation was identified:

Condition 17 of your license requires that licensed material be possessed and used in accordance with the statements, representations and procedures contained in your letter dated October 14, 1980.

Item 8 of Section III of your letter requires that daily wipe test surveys be performed in the laboratory area during periods of isotope use.

Contrary to this requirement, no surveys were performed on May 15 and 22, 1980 and September 11 and 12, 1980, when microcurie quantities of carbon-14 were used in research experiments.

This is a Severity Level V Violation. (Supplement VII)

Pursuant to the provisions of 10 CFR 2.201, Department of Health and Services, U.S. Public Health Service Hospital, is hereby required to submit to this office within twenty-five days of the date of this notice, a written statement or explanation in reply, including: (1) the corrective steps which have been taken and the results achieved; (2) corrective steps which will be taken to avoid further violations; and (3) the date when full compliance will be achieved. Under the authority of Section 182 of the Atomic El. Ty Act of 1954, as amended, this response shall be submitted under oath or affirmation.
