We are currently conducting an acceptance review of the application for operating licenses tendered on March 17, 1981. If it is determined that the application contains sufficient information to initiate a licensing review, it will be docketed. During that visit, we will invite participation by interested members of the public which, in effect, constitutes the scoping process envisioned by CEQ.
