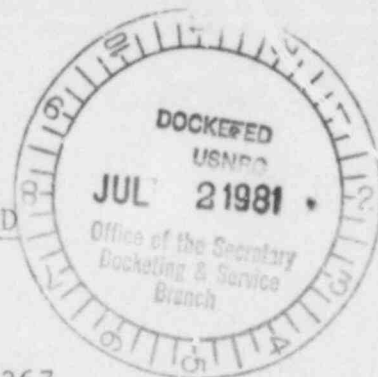

2. The reasons why NIPSCO did not complete construction of the Bailly nuclear plant by September 1, 1979;

3. All matters contained in or referred to in Contentions 1, 3, 4, 5, 7, and 8 of the Joint Intervenors' First Supplement to Petition for Leave to Intervene admitted in this proceeding by the Order Following Special Prehearing Conference, dated August 7, 1980.
