Subject: Report No. 30-1246/81-02

This refers to the investigation conducted by Mr. J. C. Howell of this office on March 11-April 1, 1981, of activities authorized by NRC License No. 47-16563-01 for Okeon Associates, Inc. Our preliminary findings were discussed with you at the conclusion of the investigation.

The investigation was an examination of the activities conducted under your license as they related to radiation safety and to compliance with the Commission's rules and regulations and the conditions of your license. The investigation consisted of selective examinations of procedures and representative records, interviews with personnel, and observations by the investigator.

During the investigation, it was found that certain activities under your license appear to violate NRC requirements. These items and references to pertinent requirements are listed in the Notice of Violation enclosed herewith as Appendix A. As indicated in Appendix A, 10 CFR 2.201 requires that you respond in writing to the Notice; however, in view of the fact that your NRC License No. 47-16563-01 expired on February 28, 1981, and since licenses of this type are now issued and renewed only for authorized medical institutions, a response to the Notice is not required.
