As of May 1, 1981 daily surveys of preparation and injection areas are being done. These surveys are performed by the nuclear medicine technician.

Weekly surveys were not recorded between April 15, 1979 and June 20, 1980. The individual responsible for maintaining those records has been terminated. Since June 20, 1980 when we hired a new nuclear technician, records have been maintained.

I will spot check to see if the daily surveys are being done and check records periodically to see that they are being kept. Nuclear Medicine Associates will also check to see if the daily surveys are being done and records of weekly surveys are performed.
