My letter concerns the rule to strengthen the ruling that utilities that want to build nuclear plants should have financial ability to take care of a clean up in case of an accident. I feel this is very important, since the average taxpayer should not have to do this. The utility companies profits are usually high enough to take care of this - the public is paying enough for utilities already - why must we pay for clean up?

Since I live quite close to the West Valley Radioactive Dump Area, I am somewhat conscious of this. We are very much aware in Western New York of dangerous toxic wastes and are aware of the tremendous costs of clean up of toxic dumps. Therefore, I do feel the NRC should work on strengthening the rule to include proof of financial clean up in the event of an accident.
