In it responses, the ifcensee confirmed that activities required to address the issue of substandard molded case circuit brcakers discussed in Bulletin 88-10 have been performed or will be performed on an acceptable schedule A detalled technical review of the licensee's responses has not been performed; however, the area may be subject to inspection at a later date. ff a subsequent inspection identifies deficiencies in the licensee's act ons and responses, this issue will be reopened. Presently we consider this ction complete.

SUBJECT: ADVANCED NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULEMAKING "ACCEPTANCE \\ OF PRODUCTS PURCHASED FOR USE IN NUCLEAR POWER \\ PLANT STRUCTURES, SYSTEMS AND COMPONENTS"

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The Cffice of Nuclear Reactor Regulation requests that the Committee to Review Generic Requirements (CRGR) consider the enclosed proposed Advance Notice of Proposed Rulemaking (ANPR). Recent experience has shown that some products purchased for use in nuclear power plant structures, systems and components are substandard, have falsified records or are otherwise misrepresented.

The ANrR solicits public comment on a list of issues related to the procurement of produces for use at nuclear power plants. The issues are posed in the forint of questions. This is done to elicit comments that may suggest the appropriate regulatory course of action. This is the action necessary io enhance the probability thai structures, systems and components installed in nuclear power plants will perform as expected. The performance expectation is that the products will perform their intended safety functions or that they will perform the normal functions in a manner which will avoid challenges to the plant safety systems.

Enclosed is the proposed ANPR and the information required to support the issuance of the ANPR. The staff will brief the CRGR on the ANPR on fraudulent materials. Brian K. Grimes, Director of Reactor Inspection and Safeguards, is the sponsoring Division Director.
