Aircraft Crash Detection System


Dear Sir:

Reference (a) transmitted a request for an amendment to Operating License Nos. DFR-39 and DPR-48, for Zion Generating Station to remove the requirements for the Aircraft Crash Detection System from the Technical Specifications. Upon review of the supporting Fluor Daniel material by NRC personnel, a request for additional information was verbally transmitted to Commonwealth Edison personnel during a September 8, 1989, telephone conversation. References (b) and (c) established a need to expeditiously submit a response to the verbal request.
