

NOTICE OF VIOLATION

Soil and Structures, Inc.

License No. 21-20312-01

As a result of the inspection conducted on November 14, 1989, and in accordance with the "General Statement of Policy and Procedure for NRC Enforcement Actions," 10 CFR Part 2, Appendix C, (1989) (Enforcement Policy) the following violation was identified:

License Condition No. 17 requires the licensee to conduct its program in accordance with the statements, representations, and procedures contained in certain referenced documents.

The referenced application dated September 3, 1987, states in Section 10.5 that nuclear gauges during transportation will be locked and its container placed in a portion of the vehicle which can be locked.

Contrary to the above, on November 14, 1989, a nuclear gauge was found to be unlocked while being transported in its container.

This is a Severity Level IV violation (Supplement VI).

Pursuant to the provisions of 10 CFR 2.201, you are required to submit to this office within thirty days of the date of this Notice a written statement or explanation in reply, including for each violation: (1) the corrective steps that have been taken and the results achieved; (2) the corrective steps that will be taken to avoid further violations; and (3) the date when full compliance will be achieved. Consideration may be given to extending your response time for good cause shown.
