SUBJECT: RESPONSE TO GENERIC LETTER 89-04 - INSERVICE TESTING PROGRAMS (TAC NO. 74759)

By letter dated September 29, 1989, Consumers Power Company responded to Generic Letter 89-04 for Big Rock Point. Your response said that Big Rock Point Plant's Inservice Testing Program was reviewed to ensure compliance with NRC Generic Letter 89-04. Some changes in your program were addressed in accordance with the positions stated in GL 89-04 and revised relief requests were included with your response. You also stated that these changes bring Big Rock Point Plant's ISI Program into compliance with the requirements of GL 89-04.

Two of these proposed changes, Items 3 and 6, reflect procedure development and revision yet it does not indicate when this work would be completed. The intent of the Generic Letter was to have procedures written and implemented by the end of six months from the date of receipt of GL 89-04. See question 56 from the "Minutes of the Public Meetings on Generic Letter 89-04," dated October 25, 1989.

A subsequent call to Mr. Dan Eddy after receipt of your response on October 16, 1989, confirmed that both of these items will be completed by March 1, 1990. The completion of this effort by March 1, is acceptable, however, please confirm this in writing.

It was also noted, that Item 1 referred to installation of flow meters during the 1990 refueling outage. This should include the implementation of all applicable procedures for these flow meters.
