

Response to Generic Letter 89-10

"Safety-Related Motor-Operated Valve Testing and Surveillance"

Per paragraph (1.) of the reporting requirements section of Generic Letter 89-10, the NRC requested that each licensee shall advise the NRC in writing, within 6 months of the date of this letter, that the schedule and recommendations presented in this letter will be met. HL&P has been working to develop a program for STP motor-operated valve testing and surveillance to comply with the Generic Letter. Our plans are to meet the intent and schedule set in the Generic Letter. However, as the NRC is aware, there are ongoing industry efforts, which STPEGS is participating in, to further clarify and establish a detailed MOV testing program. Should we identify a significant change to our commitment of compliance to the Generic Letter during our detailed program development, we will advise the NRC as needed.



AFFIDAVIT
